

# EXAM PARTICIPATION IN CORONA TIMES

When am I allowed to come to a HAN location and what should I do if I can't participate in an exam on location because of corona related circumstances?

## Do you have one or more of the following symptoms?

- Cold symptoms, such as stuffy nose, runny nose, sneezing, sore throat
- Coughing
- Shortness of breath
- Raised temperature (37.5-38°C) or fever (38°C or higher)
- Sudden loss of smell and/or taste (without nasal congestion)

**PLEASE NOTE** If you do have complaints, but you have received a negative test result, you are allowed to come to school.



## Do you share a house with someone who has a temperature, fever and/or shortness of breath?

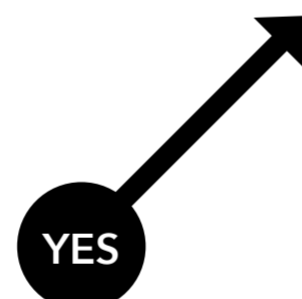
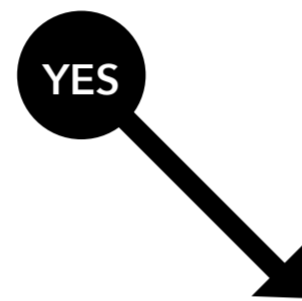
**PLEASE NOTE** If your housemate only has a cold, and has no raised temperature, fever and/or shortness of breath, you are allowed to come to HAN.



## Have you been in close contact with someone infected with corona (close contact means more than 15 minutes at a distance of less than 1.5 meters) and/or have you been in an area designated as orange or red zone due to corona in the past two weeks?

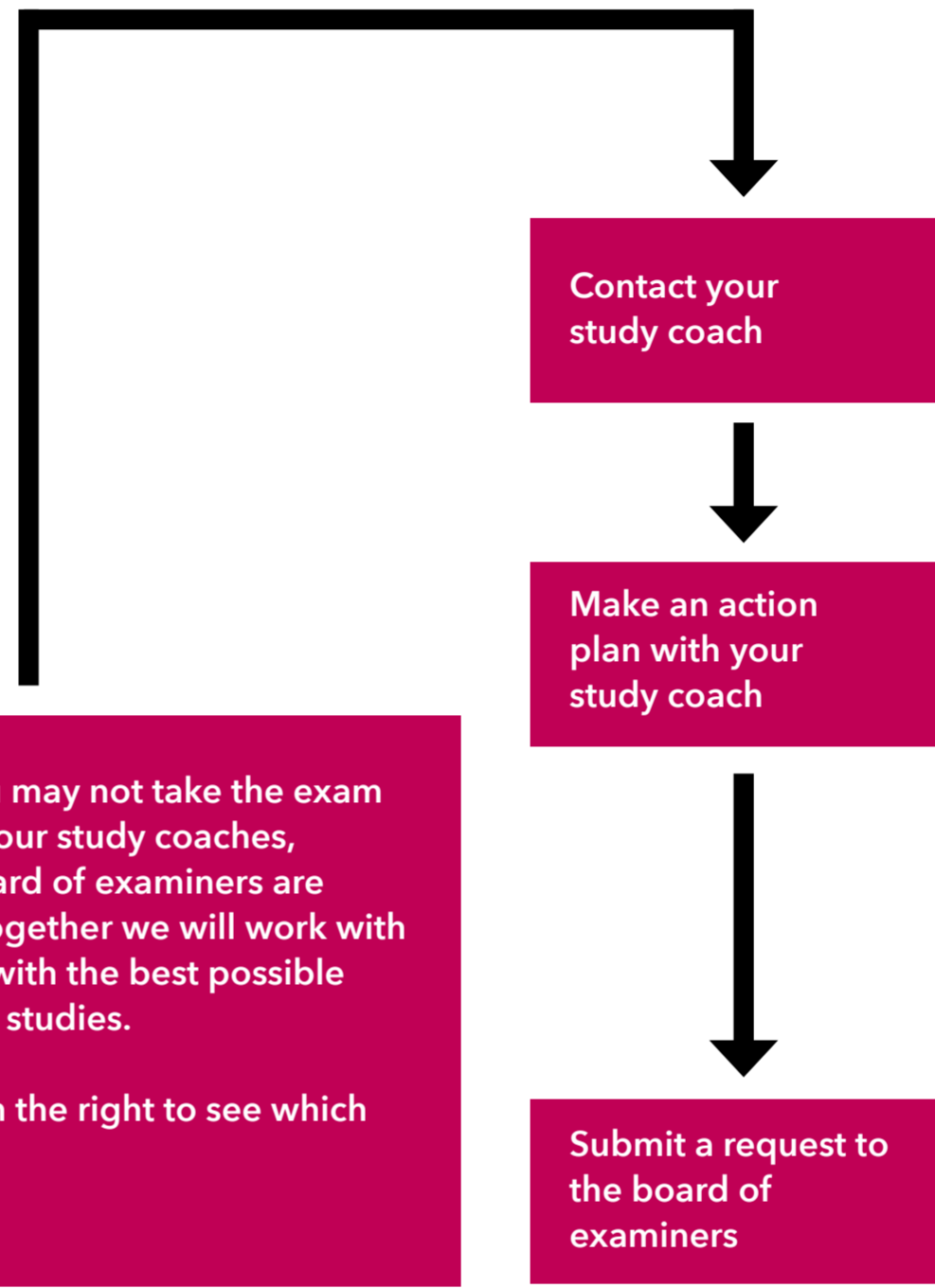


You may come to HAN to take the exam at one of the HAN locations.



In your situation you may not take the exam at a HAN location. Your study coaches, lecturers and the board of examiners are there to help you. Together we will work with you to provide you with the best possible support during your studies.

See the flowchart on the right to see which steps you can take.



- Your study coach is there for you in this unusual time. Always contact your study coach if you can't take an exam on location. Inform them about your situation.

- Consider together how it will affect you and how to best ensure your studies will continue smoothly. The regular resit opportunities may be the right solution. Or do you need a different solution, like an extra exam opportunity or an exam in a different format? Make an action plan with your study coach for this.

- If you need an extra exam opportunity, for example, or you need to take an exam in another format, please submit a request to the board of examiners. Your study coach can help you with this. When assessing your request, the board of examiners will take into account the special situation we are in and the related circumstances for you.
