Please **check your personal mailbox for the invitation**, so you know what time exactly we are expecting you!

Kindly note that these meetings are in addition to the other introduction activities organized by your own study program. Make sure to check what's going on where by clicking on your study pogram on this webpage.

Please keep in mind to follow the Dutch Corona measures during your stay here in the Netherlands and at HAN:

- Stay 1.5 metres away from other people;
- Wash your hands often;
- Cough and sneeze into your elbow;
- Don't shake hands with others;
- Avoid busy places and travel outside peak hours if possible;
- Wear a face mask for your own safety and those of others.

We'd like to point out the following guideline:

Even if you have been vaccinated, please **test yourself twice a week** with a self-test you can order online for free. Have you tested positive? Then don't come to HAN and get yourself tested at the Public Health Service (in Dutch: GGD). Have you tested negative, but have symptoms that could indicate corona? Stay home and get tested by the GGD. You can **order free self-tests online** until at least 1 September (**zelftestonderwijs.nl**).

You can find more information about the measures on the website of the Dutch government. For the measures taken here at HAN, please take a look at the COVID-19 news on the website of HAN.

If you're experiencing **symptoms** in the (nearby) future, **report this to your study career coach** and **make an appointment for a COVID-19 test** by calling 0800-1202, the phone number of the GGD. Stay home!

GET VACCINATED @HAN_

In our previous newsletter, we showed you how to get vaccinated upon arrival in the Netherlands. Now, HAN also gives you the opportunity to **get vaccinated on campus!**

To control the coronavirus as much and as quickly as possible and to increase our protection, it is important that as many people as possible get vaccinated. Are you not yet vaccinated? The Public Health Service (GGD) offers you the opportunity to get vaccinated at HAN in the weeks to come. It remains your own choice, not an obligation.

You'll receive more information from HAN soon.

Not able to make it to the vaccination on campus? Then you can make use of the Walk-in vaccination centre in Arnhem: Churchillplein in Velp (vaccination bus), Winkelcentrum Presikhaaf Kramersgildeplein (vaccination bus) or Vosdijk 32a. Here, you can get your first dose. Immediately and without an appointment. Don't forget your face mask, a valid ID and your BSN number when you go to a vaccination

centre! When you get your first dose you can also make an appointment for your second dose. Check this website for more info, other locations and opening hours of the different locations.

If you're unable to get a BSN number, check this website for terms and conditions to get vaccinated and how to make an appointment without a BSN number.

HAN SERVICES_

On our Instagram page and in our previous newsletter we already gave instructions on how to register at city hall and how to open up a Dutch bank account. But also how to set up your HAN account and your HAN e-mail account, and what to do in order to receive your HAN card and how to use it. Let's add the instructions for setting up your HAN WiFi once you are on campus.

EDUROAM HAN WIFI

In order to use Eduroam (HAN WiFi) you need to have your **HAN account set up**.

After setting up your HAN account, please search for Eduroam in your list of WiFi networks on your phone. Log in with your HAN account (the 5 letter combintion) plus the extention @han.nl and your password.

STUDENT VISA_

As a NON-EU student you need to be in possession of a **Dutch Residence Permit for Study Purposes** to stay and study legally in the Netherlands.

If you've entered the Netherlands without an entry visa (MVV), you have not yet provided the IND your biometrics.

Our Immigration Office will mail you the procedure.

Those students who entered the Netherlands with an entry visa (MVV), have already provided their biometric data at the Dutch Embassy. This means these student can collect their residence permit at our campus in Arnhem on Monday 20 September 2021 between 10:00 - 15:00.

REGISTRATION CITY HALL_

In our previous newsletter, we informed you about the procedure to register as a new citizen at city hall. We told you to schedule a meeting by following the steps on the website and we would like to correct step 2:

1. Leave the first rule as it is (All services)

PLEASE, DO NOT FORGET TO BRING:

- Your passport or European ID
 Card
- Your rental agreement to confirm your address

- 2. Second rule choose: Eerste inschrijving in NL, EU burger/Immigration EU citizen (for EU students) or First registration in NL, non EU citizen / Immigration non-EU citizen (for students from outside EU)
- 3. Click on 'Next'
- 4. Make your appointment
