DESCRIPTION

The Netherlands boasts one of the best healthcare systems in the world. However, the Dutch are also among the "big spenders" when it comes to healthcare-related costs. Several challenges, such as rising costs, an aging population, shortages of qualified personnel, and the integration of technology, may place the quality of this healthcare system under pressure. During this summer course, you explore, discuss and reflect on health, healthcare, healthcare-related challenges and dilemmas. You also explore solutions and innovatives to address these potential threats, such as the use of VR in healthcare.

Subjects that will be discussed include addiction, end-of-life care, euthanasia and their place in society, mental health, human trafficking, intercultural communication, healthcare and well-being: how are these integrated into Dutch society?
